- Der Tag, der ist so freudenreich, aller Kreature, denn Gottes Sohn vom Himmelreich von einer Jungfrau ist geborn; Maria, du bist auserkorn, dass du Mutter wärest.
 Was geshah so wunderlich?
 Gottes Sohn vom Himmelreich, der ist Mensch geboren.
- 3. Als wie die Sonn durchscheint das Glas mit ihrem klaren Scheine und doch nich versehret das, so merket allgemeine:
 - zu gleicher Weis geboren ward von einer Jungfrau rein und zart Gottes Sohn, der werte.
 - In ein Kripp ward er geleit, grosse Marter für uns leidt hie auf dieser Erden.

- This is the day that is so joyous for all creatures, for God's Son from Heaven is born of a virgin.
 Mary, you were chosen to be the mother.
 What wondrous thing has happened?
 God's Son from heaven has been born man.

 - In the same way was born, of a virgin pure and gentle, God's worthy Son.
