As part of the **ecumenical prayer cycle**, we ask you to pray for a particular region of the world each week. This week we pray for **Afghanistan**, **Kazakhstan**, **Kyrgyzstan**, **Mongolia**, **Tajikistan**, **Turkmenistan**, **and Uzbekistan**. **Give thanks for:** Christians who, although they are a tiny minority, have courage to witness to the gospel and find the strength to live according to God's word. Those who in spite of danger give their lives to serve others. Peace-makers struggling to end hostility and violence, particularly in Afghanistan. Movements towards democracy. Soldiers who refuse to kill their own people. The International Red Cross and Red Crescent, Doctors without Borders, Amnesty International and all who work on behalf of political prisoners and the dispossessed. Khoomi singing in Mongolia, a kind of singing where one person produces two different notes at the same time. We also pray for: **Bangladesh**, **Bhutan**, **and Nepal**. **Give thanks for:** The beauty of the mountains, rivers and forests. Christians who work together to serve the poor.
